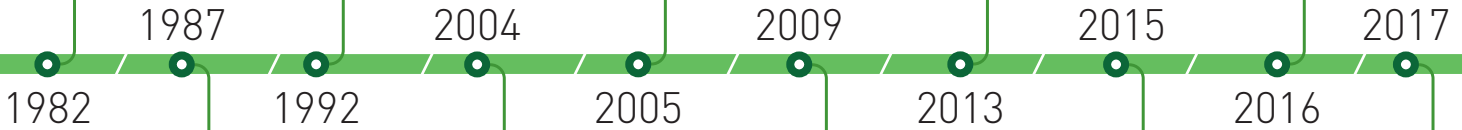

Great Canadian is listed on the TSX Venture exchange (TSX-V)

Great Canadian begins operations in Ontario with the acquisition of Georgian Downs and Flamboro Downs

Great Canadian opens Canada's only Hard Rock Casino location at its rebranded Coquitlam property, the Hard Rock Casino Vancouver, following a multi-million dollar renovation

Great Canadian receives official approval to build Shorelines Casino Belleville in Ontario

Great Canadian is listed on the Toronto Stock Exchange (TSX: GC)

Shorelines Casino Belleville opens its doors in January 2017 as Great Canadian's newest property and the first gaming facility to be built in Ontario in over 10 years

RG Check is an accreditation program created by the Responsible Gambling Council (RGC) based on its Responsible Gambling Standards for gaming venues and for Internet gambling sites. The program offers gaming companies and their Crown partners the opportunity of an independent assessment of the quality of their responsible gambling safety net. Nine of Great Canadian gaming properties in BC, as well as its two casino operations in Ontario and two in Nova Scotia, have obtained their RG Check accreditation.
