Great Canadian Casino Company Ltd., the predecessor to Great Canadian, is formed and begins operating charity casinos in a variety of locations, including Vancouver's Pacific National Exhibition casino and midway games

Great Canadian is listed on the TSX Venture exchange (TSX-V)

Great Canadian begins operations in Ontario with the acquisition of Georgian Downs and Flamboro Downs

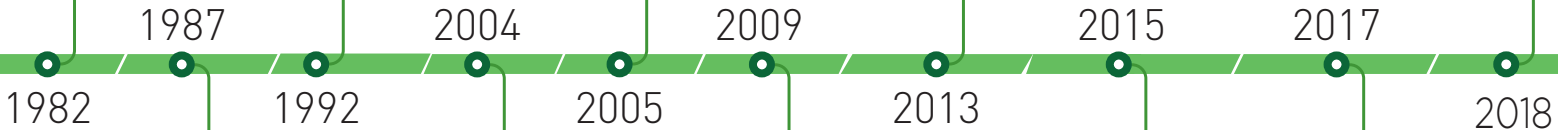
Great Canadian opens Canada's first Hard Rock Casino location at its rebranded Coquitlam property, the Hard Rock Casino Vancouver, following a multi-million dollar renovation

Great Canadian, with partners, acquire the Greater Toronto Area (GTA) Gaming Bundle, which includes Casino Ajax, Casino Woodbine, & Great Blue Heron Casino

Great Canadian, with partners, acquire the West GTA Gaming Bundle, which includes Casino Brantford, Slots at Mohawk Racetrack, Slots at Flamboro Downs, and Slots at Grand River Raceway. These properties were rebranded as Elements Casino Brantford, Elements Casino Mohawk, Elements Casino Flamboro and Elements Casino Grand River

Elements Casino Victoria launches, replacing View Royal Casino after a multimillion dollar redevelopment

Shorelines Casino Peterborough opens its doors in October. It is the second gaming property that Great Canadian has built in Ontario.

Great Canadian is listed on the Toronto Stock Exchange (TSX: GC)  
Great Canadian opens River Rock Casino Resort, which quickly becomes the company's flagship operation

Fraser Downs Racetrack and Casino undergoes a multi-million dollar renovation, and is re-introduced as Elements Casino  
Great Canadian begins operations in Moncton, New Brunswick with the acquisition of Casino New Brunswick

Great Canadian, with partners, is chosen as the first private sector operator as part of the Ontario Lottery and Gaming Corporation's modernization exercise and subsequently introduces the Shorelines Casino brand to Ontario for the gaming properties at Thousand Islands and Kawartha Downs

Shorelines Casino Belleville opens its doors in January. It is the first gaming facility built in Ontario in ten years
