

INDUSTRY CONTEXT: NEW BRUNSWICK

GCA

The Gaming Control Act establishes a framework for conducting, managing, controlling and regulating casinos and gaming in the province. It ensures that gaming operations are conducted with integrity and in the best interests of the public.

NBLGC

The New Brunswick Lotteries and Gaming Corporation (NBLGC) is a crown corporation responsible for developing, organizing, conducting and managing provincial lottery on behalf of the Province.

SERVICE PROVIDERS

Private corporations such as Great Canadian Gaming Corporation. Own and/or lease gambling facilities such as casinos, while maintaining the day-to-day facility operations. Service providers hire the staff at facilities, provide surveillance and security behind the scenes and operate to the standards set out by provincial regulators.

In New Brunswick, Great Canadian Gaming Corporation operates the casino located in Moncton and non-gaming amenities including show theatres, conference facilities and a variety of dining options.
