

INDUSTRY CONTEXT: ONTARIO

AGCO

The Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO) is a provincial agency responsible for the administration of the Liquor Licence Act, the Gaming Control Act, and as of April 1, 2016, the regulation of horse racing in Ontario.

OLG

The Ontario Lottery and Gaming Corporation (OLG) is a provincial agency that provides gaming entertainment in an efficient and socially responsible manner that maximizes benefits for the people of Ontario, related economic sectors and host communities.

SERVICE PROVIDERS

Private corporations such as Great Canadian Gaming Corporation. Own and/or lease gambling facilities such as casinos and racetracks, while maintaining the day-to-day facility operations. Service providers hire the staff at facilities, provide surveillance and security behind the scenes and operate to the standards set out by provincial regulators.

LOCATIONS



Casinos and racetracks such as Flamboro Downs and Shorelines Casino Thousand Islands, and non-gaming amenities.

In Ontario, Great Canadian Gaming Corporation manages the racing operations at Flamboro Downs and Georgian Downs, as well as the Shorelines Casino Thousand Islands and Shorelines Slots at Kawartha Downs.
